I'M EXTREMELY PROUD OF OUR PLAYERS THROUGHOUT THE SEASON, AND THERE WERE STAGES DURING OUR GRAND FINAL THAT FORRESTDALD COULD HAVE RUN AWAY FROM US, BUT IN TYPICAL FASHION THE PLAYERS SHOWED ENORMOUS HEART AND CHARACTER TO KEEP CHIPPING AWAY AND WE TRAILED BY JUST 8 POINTS AT 3/4 TIME. WAS IT GOING TO HAPPEN AGAIN? WOULD WE EVER WIN A FINALS GAME FOR BILLY? THE ANSWER WAS YES. THE WEEK AFTER WE FACED CARLISLE AT SELBY PARK, THE BOYS CLICKED AND WE LIVED TO FIGHT ANOTHER WEEK. WITH A COMPREHENSIVE WIN OVER CARLISLE, BALCATT A AGAIN.
