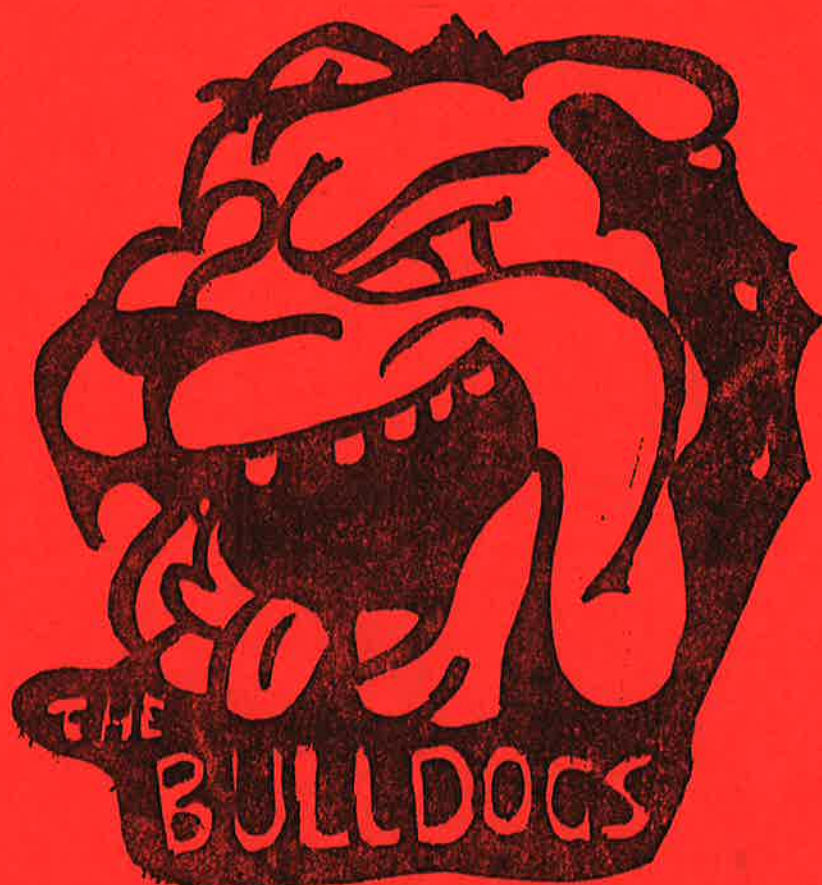

CAPTAINS REPORT 'E' GRADE

WELL ANOTHER SEASON IS OVER AND AS WE LOOK BACK TO OUR ACHIEVEMENTS FOR 1996 WE CAN HOLD OUR HEADS HIGH, EVEN THOUGH WE STUMBLER AT THE FINAL HURDLE, AND LOSE THE GRAND FINAL BY JUST A SINGLE GOAL, THE WAY IN WHICH WE FOUGHT BACK SO GALIANTLY AFTER SUCH A DISAPPOINTING FIRST HALF IN THE GRAND FINAL, SHOWS HOW MUCH TEAM SPIRIT WE HAVE DEVELOPED OVER THE YEAR WELL AT THE START OF THE YEAR THERE WAS AN INFLUX OF PLAYERS TO THE CLUB WITH NUMBERS UP AROUND THE 90 MARK AT THE START. THEN CAME THE LOW POINT OF THE YEAR, THE LOSS BY ONE POINT TO RIVALS FORRESTFIELD AT SCOTT RESERVE. THEN IT WAS SMOOTH SAILING WITH TEN GOAL PLUS WINS, UNTIL WE MET SWAN ATHLETIC AGAIN, WHICH WAS PLAYED ON THEIR COW Paddock. THEN IT WAS THE NIGHT GAME AT THE CLUB, IT WAS A GREAT SPECTACULAR AND THE GAME WAS A GOOD WIN TOO. JUST WHAT WE NEEDED BEFORE THE FINALS, A COMFORTABLE WIN OVER OCEAN RIDGE SET UP ANOTHER SHOW DOWN WITH SWAN ATHLETIC, THIS WAS A GREAT GAME WHICH WE NARROWLY LOST. THEN THE PRELIMINARY THAT A HEART STOPPER THAT WAS, WE NARROWLY MADE IT THROUGH, BUT IN HINDSIGHT WE REALLY STOLE THE GAME OFF THEM.
