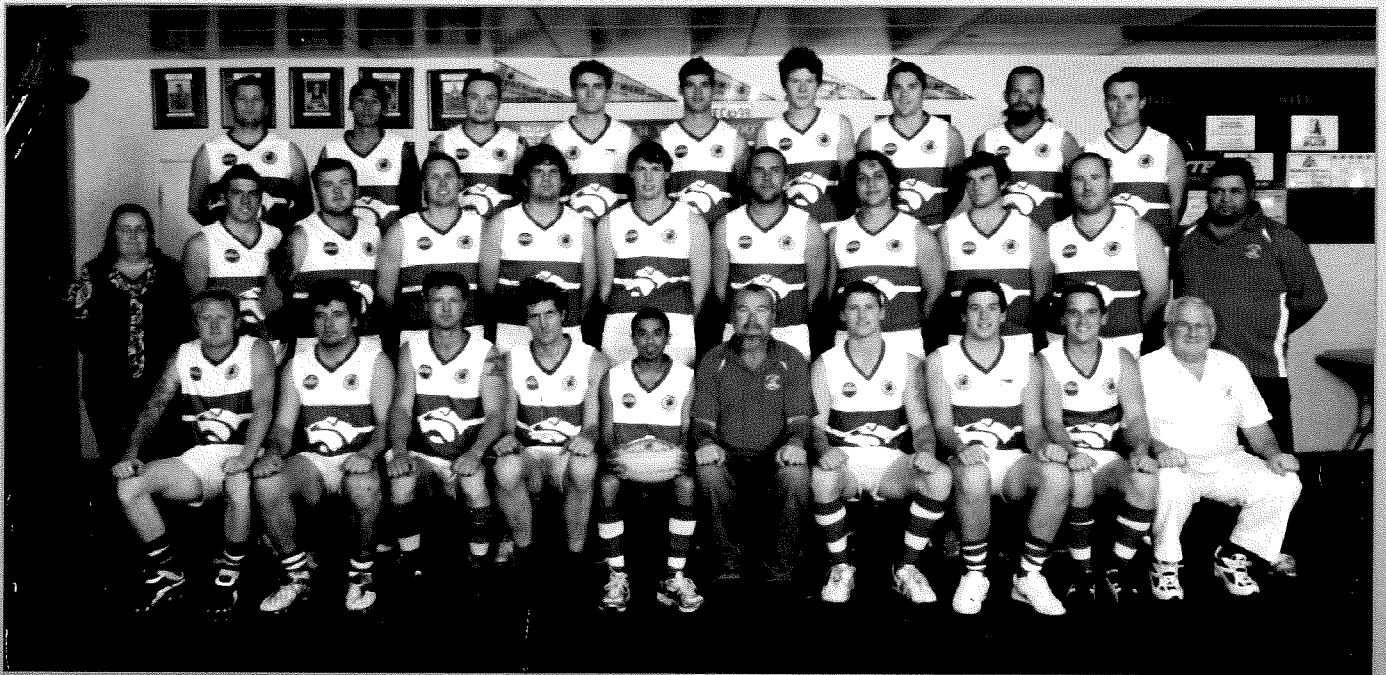

The junior club is run very well and at the end of the day we want those kids playing senior footy with High Wycombe eventually.

It was very pleasing to see kids like Rukkas, Lukey D, Copey and these boys get a taste of league footy this year and see what is needed to step up to that level and have kids such as Bods, Scotty Wolf, Stints and Richie Kennedy as regular players and play a very important role in the league side this year.

The league's season was very pleasing we set ourselves some goals early and we pretty much stuck to those goals as we worked our way to finals, we probably finished one place short of where we wanted to be but we accepted where we were at and new to make an impact on the finals we needed to step up which we did with a show of force and skill to claim our second finals appearance.

Our first half of the season was very steady apart from two games in which we were taught footy lessons which the boys and coaches learnt from. We were able to get to the half way mark fairly successfully sitting in third on two losses. This happened mainly due to the availability of all players we had very few injuries apart from two knee injuries one season ending for Doodle who would have made a huge difference to our prospects this year and one to Ozzie who has now fought his way back into the league side. So really the side changed very little, keeping some fantastic talent in the twos as there were not league spots available. Then the injuries came to key players in Scarders and Chesty which were long term injuries at that, this opened up opportunities for players to come into the league side and we looked to youth to fill those positions which really did inject some enthusiasm and much needed run into the side.

Mitch Stinton, Richard Kennedy, Sean Bods and Scotty Wolf really had a huge impact on our side once positions became available for them and with Stints and Richie coming in at round 12 and still being colts players it was amazing to see them adapt so quickly and fit into the team so well. Obviously Bods and Scotty, Cody Rybka had a taste of league last season and easily handled the pace.

In our second half we started off with two heartbreaking losses games we knew we should have won and I think those losses really steeled us we want to win, we want to play finals was the feedback to Matty and myself from the players and that was great to hear because that's what we wanted desperately, you don't play footy for any other reason than to get as far as you can in finals.

From there we played some great footy especially our close loss to Kingsway at their ground they knew that day what a tough, relentless side we are and that showed the boys and coaches we can beat anyone once we get going, we knew we would be dangerous in the finals. We had a huge slip up in the final round getting flogged by Ocean Ridge which cost us third spot on the ladder and the double chance. # H GRADE REPORT 2009

What a quality year for the football club reaching finals in all grades, something everybody should be enormously proud of. Firstly well done to the league our yardstick for the clubs strength wonderfully led by Doyley in his first year and very well assisted by Matty Weston, Norm and Owie. The reserves and colts were fantastic all year led by Wozza and Nathan, and the colts by Banksy and Dermie; both teams deserving their top 2 finishes. The H Grade season was solid and sometimes spectacular winning five and losing three to halfway then winning five and losing three in the second half.

So I suppose you would say we were the model of consistency, in the process of a ten and six win loss record we maintained a solid percentage just above 160 percent at seasons end a pretty impressive figure. Alongside the good performances in winning ten games very well our six losses were in most cases very honourable and honest performances. I must make special mention to all the player group for their patience and comradery at times having to sit out games to allow team mates their chance as our numbers at thirds were terrific all season. We in fact put 61 players through thirds this year, the second largest number in the league 2nd only to CBC who put through 67 but CBC regularly used colts players to bolster their side. To our credit we use only 2 colts in an entire year and that was in one game only so thank you to Tim Miller and Lucas McCahon.

Our season didn't go without a few bad losses as far as players went, losing Mick Thomas in game one to a season ending ankle injury, the same fate for Justin Joseph in round eight, round four saw us lose Matt Dyce for the season to a knee injury, round three we lost standout ruckman Kyle Hey back to Basketball State League and round nine our big man Alex Fergusson Stewart finished his wonderful season with a break in his sternum. Several others had to bow out for periods of the season with various injuries, but as a whole our season went without too many real nasties.

One shining light for the season was managing to get old sailor boy Tonner (Anton Mahalic) back for the last two games without breaking him and making him the oldest player at the club to play at 49 and 10 months, good effort. We managed to get two blokes to major milestones during the year, Robbie Rowlands 200 games awesome and Daniel (Hotdog) Huisman 150 both terrific efforts, several others played milestones 50's-100's to those guys, well done.

We welcomed many new players to both the club and especially H grade this year. To those new players thanks for your great contribution and I hope you are settled in and enjoyed your first season at the club.

To all the people associated with H grade this year I must say a huge thank you.
