C GRADE REPORT 2011

This year was a difficult one for the club with our home ground Scott reserve once again being unavailable for pre-season training, this put everyone involved, players, coaches and committee in a stressed environment with the search for grounds to train at, players unsure of where and when training was taking place, lights at venues being unavailable or the ground being used by other sporting clubs. The constant picking up and dropping off of training gear, trainers equipment and water bottles etc. was a real headache. We really didn't settle back into Scott reserve until round 3 so for the start we had I think the league side did very well to make the 5 and keep the club in C1 for another season.

Our season started well with a good mixture of young players including colts and our experienced seniors taking to the field we only lost 3 games for the first round one by a point to Scarborough who played in the 2010 GF and look like taking part in the 2011 GF and a thrashing by a highly skilled Kelmscott side who had recruited well in the off season and a 4 goal loss to the much fancied Bullcreek who also took part in the 2010 GF in C Gold. Thanks to my son Billy for doing boundary for the resses and for helping out with the runners job in the league and to all my family for putting up with me for another season of footy. Many thanks to Weasel for giving me a hand to coach during the year I was struggling there a bit but he got me back on track with some wisdom and insight on the bench game day and some great training drills on the track, he is a great club person he loves his footy and most importantly he loves HW cheers mate.

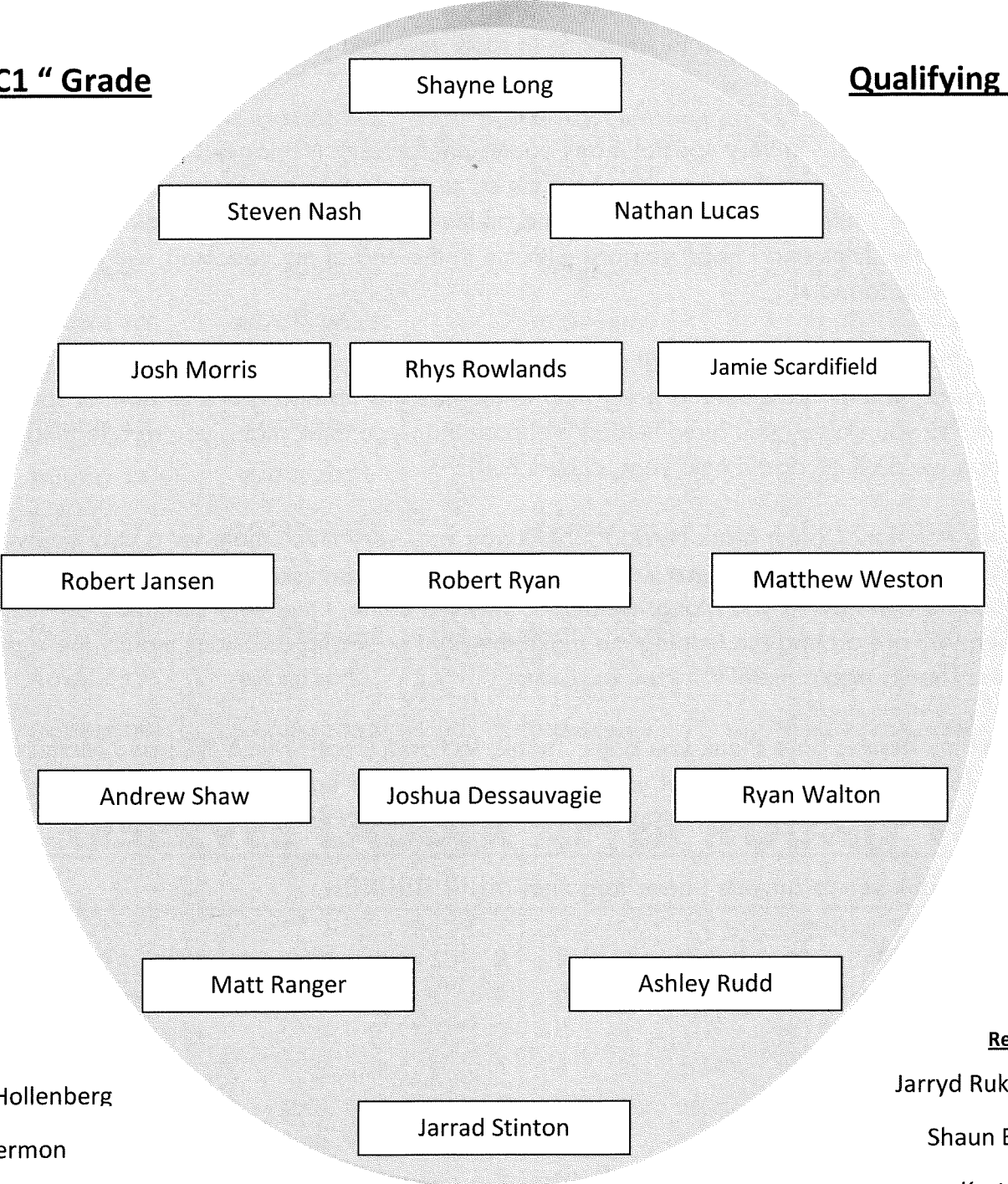
